

Credit Card Payments

It is possible to pay in most Dutch supermarkets and in other types of shops with a credit card, using the contactless payment method. However, there is often a limit of €50 per contactless transaction (although this may vary per shop) and if you do three contactless transactions consecutively (i.e. without using your pin code), you must use your pin code for the next transaction.

To use your credit card

1. Look for the contactless payment symbol:



2. Look for the VISA and/or the MasterCard logo:



3. You can pay by holding your credit card to the payment machine where indicated, either at the top or on the side of the machine. The location is indicated by the contactless payment symbol.



You must use your pin code when using this payment method for the first time. After that, you do not have to use the pin code, unless consecutive transactions exceed the amount of €150.

4. The pin machine will confirm if the payment has succeeded.



Which shops accept payment with a credit card?

You can pay in the following shops with a credit card, although it is best to check first by looking for the Visa/Master Card logo:

In addition, the *Bijenkorf* department store and the home electronics and household appliances chain, *BCC*, also accept credit card payments.

You can also withdraw money from an ATM (or cash machine) with a credit card, although check if transaction fees will be charged.

Please note: you cannot pay your Tilburg University tuition fees with a credit card.
